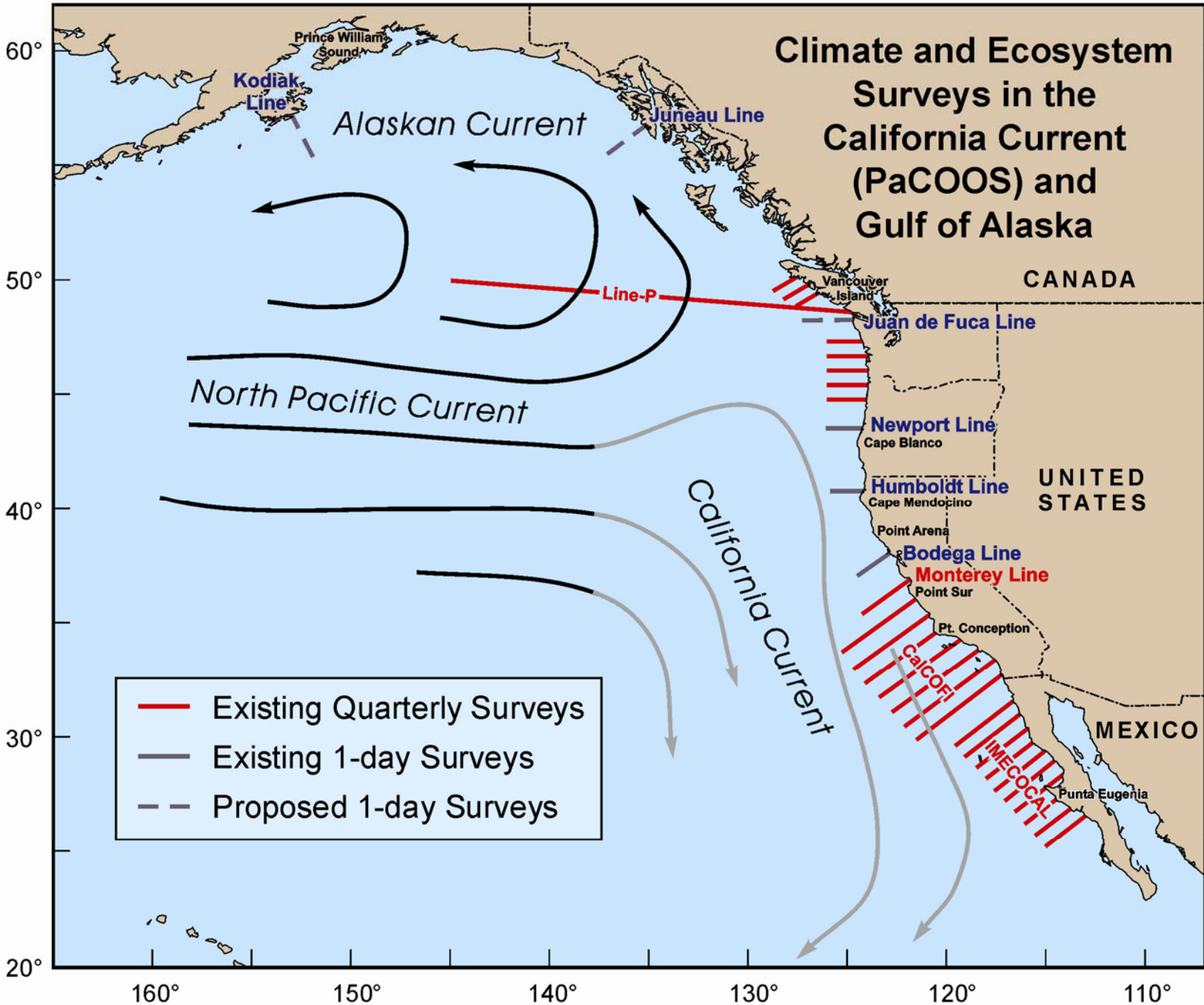
- Quarterly Summary of climate and ecosystems in the CA Current
